Puerto Rico at a Franciscan Monastery devoted to helping the poor. He gives all the credit for his vocation to our Lady of Garabandal. Fr. Jose was present during many of the Apparitions. He says the strength and firmness of his Priesthood could never be without his devotion to his Mother, Mary! Fr. When she is not running, she is helping around the house and garden doing most of the heavy work.
